Water Bottle Art - Make a kaleidoscope from a cardboard tube and water bottle (safe mirrors on interior). It works as well as any kaleidoscope you'd buy. Also make and decorate a hummingbird feeder with stopper and glass tube and a seed filled bird feeder, both from water bottles. Time: 2 hours, Cost: \$18 per child	Beginner Mosaics - Break and nip tiles and glass (goggles & gloves provided) to design, create and grout a mosaic which can be used as a wall hanging or trivet. Includes discussion of the history of mosaics and examination of ancient mosaics as inspiration. A two-day project. 2 time slots of 1.5 hours each, Cost \$35 total per child

Mobile Magic - Use fabulous materials to make a colorful summer mobile. Clear Acrylic "Clouds" have predrilled holes and can be painted with glass paint and embellished. Then hang beads, chimes, spoons, flowers...you name it. Time: 1.5 hours, Cost: \$12 per child	Stained Glass Suncatcher - Score, break, foil and solder glass as well as learn pattern making. Learn the tiffany stained glass method and make your own stained glass suncatcher. A two-day project *AGES 10 AND UP. 2 time slots of 2.5 hours each, Cost \$50 total per child
Amazing Insects - Explore the amazing insect world using reference books, design, build and paint a large replica of your favorite amazing bug from unconventional materials such as sculptable styrofoam and cellophane. Time: 1.5 hours, Cost \$15 per child	
Bucket Hats - Use Fabric Sprays, paints, fabric markers, stencils and embellishments to make a special hat for summer. Time: 1.5 hours, Cost \$15 per child
